#### **Trackside Assistants**

Allocation of Trackside Assistants Will occur for the Meeting for **Cadet / Junior Classes** in accordance with General Rules, Chapter 4, Rule 12. ## Pit Crew/Participant Licence

Any persons who seek or require access to the circuit, the in grid, the out grid, scrutineering and parc ferme areas must hold either a current Pit Crew/Drivers licence or a Participation licence if the driver is a minor.

### Pit Paddock Allocation

Pit Paddock allocation Will NOT occur for the Meeting -. No Marquees / tents or trailers to be left at track prior to Meeting or pit spots marked out without consent of the Club.
